Sunshine Coast Youth Soccer Cup June 21-22, 2025

The Sunshine Coast Youth Cup will take place on the beautiful Sunshine Coast, in British Columbia. The tournament will offer competitive and recreational divisions for U8 to U18 Girls and Boys, with a minimum of 4 guaranteed games for each team. The tournament is sanctioned by BC Soccer, and is open to Canadian and U.S. teams.

Registration will open on December 1st, 2024, and will close on June 7th, 2025. Early bird pricing will be offered until March 31st, 2025.

GENERAL INFORMATION

General:

All traveling teams should be prepared to play their first games as early as 9:30am, on Saturday, June 21, 2025, and as late as 6:30pm on Sunday, June 22, 2025. These game times align with the 7:30 am ferry leaving Horseshoe Bay (West Vancouver), and the 8:15pm ferry leaving Langdale (Sunshine Coast). Requests for later start or earlier end game times will be considered, but not guaranteed.

BC Ferries:

We recommend teams book reservations on BC Ferries to ensure smooth travel. If teams are wanting to walk on the ferry, <u>Coastal Rides</u> can also provide a great alternative, as they can shuttle teams to the fields. <u>Click Here for BC Ferries</u>

Teams traveling from Vancouver would sail out of Horseshoe Bay in West Vancouver, to Langdale (Gibsons).

U8-U10: Early Bird \$350; General \$400 U11-U13: Early Bird \$400; General \$450 U14-U18: Early Bird \$450; General \$500

All fields on the Sunshine Coast are natural grass. Please wear appropriate footwear. Fields are located in Gibsons, Roberts Creek, Sechelt and Halfmoon Bay.
